<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL – Meeting at Cemetery or Crematorium Only (funeral director's charges only)</b>	<b>£2644.00</b>
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements of traditional funeral service</li> <li>Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care</li> <li>Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. <sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

<sup>2</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
